Guidelines for Internet Use

1. All students must have a signed permission slip from their parents that authorizes them access to the Internet.
2. Respect for the equipment of The Marshall School is a condition for use of the computers.
3. Students must always respect the privacy of files of other users. Do not enter the file areas of other students or staff without obtaining permission from them first.
4. Students are to notify the teacher immediately of any disturbing material they may encounter on the web or in e-mail.
5. Students are not to give out personal information like telephone number, full name, address, etc. to anyone on the Internet.
6. Students are to never give anyone their password to any of their accounts or allow another student to use their account to access the Internet or school network.
7. Students must gain clearance from the teacher before downloading any programs from the Internet.
8. All floppies brought to the lab or library to be used in the computers must first be scanned for viruses by the teacher.
9. Computers will be used for educational purposes only.
